Employees of Princeton University:

You are eligible to participate in the Princeton University Retirement Savings Plan. This supplemental retirement plan allows you to contribute pre-tax monies directly from your paycheck and invest in a variety of investment funds. If you would like to enroll in the Retirement Savings Plan for the first time or change your current deferral election, you may do so at any time during the year.

To enroll in the Retirement Savings Plan, you must send an email to benefits@princeton.edu and request the enrollment information. If you do not make an investment choice your contributions will default into the Vanguard Target to Retirement Fund closest to the year you reach age 65.
